

Outrageous Felted Wool Fleece Lined Mittens

- Remember that you are working to fit a right and left hand. Reverse your thinking, cutting and sewing accordingly.
 - Measure and mark 45/8" from bottom of front(A) and lower palm (B)
 - With right sides facing, place lower palm (B) and upper palm (C) together
 - Sew (B) and (C) together curving stitching toward stopping point (a)
- With right sides together, place Front (A) to completed mitten palm (B &C)
- Sew front (A) to completed palm (B&C) starting at bottom and ending at mark (a) on palm side and mark (b) on front side
 - With right sides together place front (A) and completed palm (B & C) together
 - Sew the remainder of the mitten seam by starting at the bottom, going toward the mitten tip and then stopping at mark (a) and corresponding mark (b)
 - Make linings in same manner as mittens
 - Place lining in corresponding mitten with wrong sides together
 - Using yarn, sew mitten and lining together using long basting stitches
 - Attach cuff to mitten at side seams and mid-palm side using matching yarn or embroidery floss
 - Use a square knot at attachment point
- Mittens are to be hand washed like a wool sweater using baby shampoo and lukewarm water
- Rinse in lukewarm water, towel dry then air dry. Do not place in hot water or dryer unless you want to give them to a Barbie Doll
